Butter Churning

Tuesday, July 11, 1:00-2:00 pm

Colonial children had lots of chores, one of which was to help make butter. Learn about the process of churning cream into butter and make some to take home!

Tin Punching

Tuesday, July 18, 1:00-2:00 pm

Colonial homes often had items, such as lanterns and cupboards, that were decorated with tin pierced designs. Learn about the craft of tin punching and make a project using this technique!

Spinning Yarns

Tuesday, July 25, 1:00-2:00 pm

In Colonial times, during sheep-shearing season, wool was gathered and prepared for spinning and weaving. Learn about the process of wool preparation and work with yarn to create a take-home project!

Colonial children didn't have electronic toys or factory-made games! Toys were handmade with scraps of items, such as wood and string. Learn how children entertained themselves during playtime and make a simple toy to take home! If weather permits, this session will take place outdoors.
