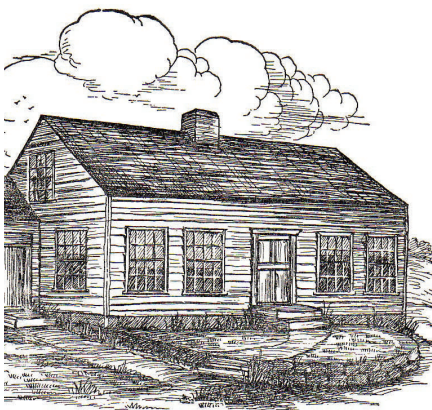


# 2011 Southeast Historic Sites Tour
