Saturday June 18 at 10:00AM Kid's Program Who are you? A workshop on family history: Bring a family photo, share your story and make a craft based on your history.

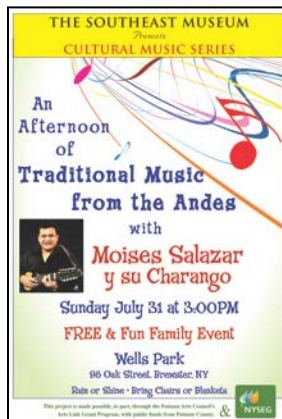
Saturday June 25 at 10:00AM Kid's Program Worry Dolls: Learn the tradition of worry dolls and make your own doll.
